

## **Aubrey Hall** Aug 1, 1937 – May 8, 2013

Aubrey Hall passed away after a long illness. He was a long time member of CRPC and a lifetime member of the NRA.

He was a dedicated service rifle shooter and shot with the Virginia State Association high power rifle teams in 1979 and 1980 when they won  $2^{nd}$  and  $1^{st}$  place at Camp Perry National Matches. Amazingly, he shot his M 1 left handed and during Infantry Trophy matches, could change clips in his M 1 faster than others using M 14s. Throughout his lifetime, Aubrey continued to use his M 1 even though everyone else had switched to M 14s or something else.

Not content to just shoot, Aubrey actively recruited new shooters and would train or coach anyone who asked. He also worked with Jim Morgan to develop the junior rifle team. His efforts played a major part in making the state team a powerhouse during the mid 70s - 80s.

The knowledge and help Aubrey generously provided will continue to benefit us well into the future. He will be missed.
